- **Entries must be submitted on one side of an A4 page only in Arial size 10 or 12 font in a Microsoft Word document or PDF file. Lines must be spaced at 1.5pt.**
- All entries must include a completed entry form (scanned and attached to email). Entry is free.
- Limit of two entries per person. Entrants must be Victorian residents.
- Entries close Friday 20 November 2015 at 5.00pm.
- Entrants will be invited to attend and present their work at Hatch Contemporary Arts Space on Thursday 26 November 2015 at 7.00pm. Entrants will receive an invitation to the event via email.
- By submitting a piece of prose or poetry, the entrant grants Yarra Plenty Regional Library and Banyule City Council the right to display and publish the work digitally, in print and online.
